

## SHAKE IT UP

## ROUGE

SPEED STYLE

Not enough time to style a full head of hair? "Massage dry shampoo into your roots to give texture, then add polish to just the parts people see. Take a tong to the top layer and leave the underneath to do its natural thing," advises hairstylist Dee Parker Attwood. Always spritz strands with a heat protector mist before using tools.
