keep it coral

Loud lips are a huge trend right now but, if you prefer

a subtle effect, opt for a juicy coral glow. **1** Conceal any redness on your face, like near the nose, chin and forehead. This is essential whenever you use coral tones.

2 Make sure you tone down the rest of your make-up, especially around the eyes, so that it doesn't clash with the vibrant shade of gloss. Black liner on top and bottom lash lines will define the eye area without overshadowing the lips.

3 Apply a generous amount of gloss with your finger. If you want a more professional look, use a nude liner all over lips, then apply the gloss with a lip brush.

sorbet nails

Nothing marks the shift of seasons like the change of nail polish shades from dark and subdued to flashes of colour that look good enough to eat.

1 Always prep the nails with a base coat to prevent a stained nail bed and make the polish last longer.

2 Unlike nude or baby pink, it's easier to see mistakes when using sorbet tones. Without overloading the brush with polish, start with one thick stroke down the middle of the nails and then do a stroke on either side.

3 Allow the nails to touch dry and finish with a glossy topcoat.

severe side part

The middle part dominated 2011, but the extreme side part is edging up to be a way cooler sister-trend. Move your part right on over for a chic updated look.

1 Work a small amount of volume styling mousse through wet hair. Choose a side and then, using a wide-tooth comb, align your part with the arch of your eyebrow.

2 Comb the smaller section of hair behind the ear and work the larger part of hair slightly forward so that it falls across the face to the opposite ear.

3 Blow-dry the hair across with a round ceramic brush until it sits in the side sweep position. Finish with a spritz of hairspray to hold it in place.
