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## 5 CHEEKY EXFOLIATING TRICKS

**Circles work.** Instead of scrubbing your face up and down, buff in a circular motion. It prevents the skin from pulling and gives you a more thorough exfoliation. For a skin fix on the go, try Nivea Pure Effect 3-in-1 Daily Deep Cleansing Exfoliating Wipes, \$7.50, 1800 103 025.

**Glycolic is a win.** The fruit acid eats away at dead cells so you don't need to physically scrub. Opt for a night serum and let it work its magic while you snooze. Try Olay Regenerist Night Resurfacing Elixir, \$49.99, olay.com.au.

**Swap your mask for a peel.** If your skin is congested, your regular monthly DIY mask might not be enough. Switch to a peel instead – use one with fruit acids and it'll keep pores from getting clogged.

**Buff that body.** It's easy to underestimate how dry the rest of us gets. Look for a gel-based scrub – the granules are suspended, making them less scratchy.

**Try it dry.** When in doubt, exfoliating dry skin gives a smoother finish. This move isn't always great for the face – especially for sensitive skin – but you can go to town on super-rough areas like the soles of your feet.
