How to look great every day

Learn to use hot rollers

Bouncy, glamorous curls can be a little bit fiddly. Learn to master them like our staffer Jessica Multari

1 PREP Apply a smoothing lotion to wet hair on ends and mid-lengths. Blast with an ionic dryer until completely dry, then brush hair to remove any knots.

2 ROLL Divide hair into four large sections from left to right, then divide each into five smaller sections from front to back. Pull each straight, place the roller under the hair at the ends and roll down, away from the face. Secure with a clip. Repeat on all sections.

3 SET Once all the rollers are in place, mist with hairspray. Wait until the rollers have cooled and remove. To finish, gently brush out the curls with a paddle brush and spritz with more hairspray.

Handy hot rolling tips

Dateline Imports' Linda Curtis says:

- ◆ Ensure hair is dry and tangle-free.
- ◆ Always use a heat protectant.
- ◆ Only use 2cm sections of hair.
- ◆ Use large rollers to create volume and small rollers for tight curls.
- ◆ Allow rollers to cool completely before removing. This usually takes about 20 minutes but the longer you leave them the better the result.
- ◆ Avoid immediate contact with the skin so you don't burn yourself.
- ◆ Removing rollers before they have cooled will cause the curls to drop.
