BEAUTY SCHOOL:

the top knot

THE BUN FOR SUMMER.

Super hot weather calls for two things. Strawberry gelati (of course), and a cute no-fuss hairstyle. Enter: the top knot. It's the kind of style that oozes "I didn't even try and I still look this hot". And, it's so easy to do it's almost embarrassing. Here's how...

Step one: Prep it up

Brad Ngata, director of Brad Ngata Hair Direction Salons, Sydney, tells us to get the perfect messy top knot hair should be a little gritty and lived in. To get the textured look, spray either some sea salt spray or dry shampoo on dry hair. If you want even more volume, you can tease your hair with a tail comb. And, as with most styles, it works best with one-day-old hair.

Step two: Tie it up

Now that you've volumised your hair, sweep it into a ponytail and secure it with an elastic at the top of your head. Next, twist it and then wrap the ends around the elastic in a circular motion. Once you've done this you can secure the bun with bobby pins.

Step three: Mess it up

Brad says to make it look more messy, you should pull out some strands of hair from the side of your head or even from the top, and then backcomb them a little. Finally, use some hair spray to hold the look and, bam!, you're done – so quick and easy!

THREE EXTRA TIPS:

- Messy isn't for you? Well, that's where the sleek top knot comes in. This time when you go to tie your hair into a ponytail, brush it neatly upwards and then tie it up and continue as usual. This'll make it a whole lot sleeker.
- If you have fine hair and want to add even more volume to your bun, just tug little bits of hair out of the bun to make it bigger.
- And finally, for those with thick hair, once you've tied your hair in a ponytail, plait it, and then continue as normal. Plaiting it will stop your bun from falling out, which can happen with thick hair.
