Prior to attending an appointment, how should a client prepare their skin?

The evening or morning prior to waxing, clients should shower and exfoliate the area to be waxed. This prepares the skin and makes the treatment a little more pleasant, especially if they have dry skin. Clients should also ensure they have no moisturiser or deodorant on the skin prior to the treatment as this will prevent the wax adhering properly.

The client should ensure their skin is thoroughly cleansed and exfoliated.

The client should exfoliate the night prior to the waxing appointment and should also be sure the skin is perfectly clean with no creams, oils or residue to allow the wax to adhere.

Your client should have a cool shower before any waxing appointment to make sure their body temperature isn't too hot; if the client is hot and sweaty the wax won't stick. Do not moisturise the skin before waxing, or use any deodorant before under arm waxing. Prior to Brazilian waxing you may be required to trim hair.

Make sure the skin is in a hygienic condition. Shower beforehand and give yourself a light exfoliation as this will assist in the removal of dead skin cells, making hair removal a lot easier. Apply a light body moisturiser afterwards to keep the skin supple. If you are on any medication or having any particular medical treatment, advise your therapist.

Prior to all waxing appointments, it is recommended to regularly exfoliate and moisturise your skin and to have minimal sun exposure. Exfoliation helps to remove any dead skin cells and unblock hair follieles, allowing the hair to be removed more easily. If having your underarms waxed, be sure not to wear deodorant to your appointment as this can cause irritation. For all other areas of your body, ensure skin is clean, dry and free of any oils and moisturisers.

"Professional waxes today have come a long way. Many years ago the industry preferred the traditional hard waxing method. However, modern salon conditions today require a waxing method which is cost-efficient, immediately ready for use and hygienic as well as efficient."

Do you recommend different types of professional wax for different areas of the body?

Strip wax is predominantly used in most beauty salons, and can be used on all areas of the body as it is quicker to work with and more cost-effective for salon owners. Hot wax is also being used by many salons; this wax is gentler on areas such as the bikini zone, facial area and underarms. The density of the hair should be assessed prior to waxing, and this should determine the type of wax to be used.

We recommend Lycon hot and

Lycojet waxes for the more delicate areas such as face, underarms and Brazilian area. In addition, we recommend Lycon Pre-Waxing Oil before and during all hot waxing. With a special blend of oils that incorporates aromatherapy, it pre-soothes the skin prior to waxing and prevents wax from sticking to skin, particularly if it needs to be reapplied to the same area more than once. Lycon hot and Lycojet waxes have a very low temperature, remove hair as short as 1mm and can be applied on the same area five to six times without discomfort or lifting the skin. Lycon strip

We recommend the use of hot wax for sensitive areas such as face, underarm and the bikini line and Brazilian area.

Liquid strip wax is recommended for larger areas such as legs, arms, back and less sensitive areas. Strip wax can be quicker and remove larger areas at a time. Hot wax is recommended for smaller, sensitive areas, such as eyebrows, underarms, facial hair and bikini hair. It is slightly gentler on the skin and is applied warm. Hot wax is removed once dry, and it cools to constrict around the hair, trapping it for removal.

An incorrect waxing technique is the number -one risk factor for developing ingrown hairs. If the wax isn't removed in the same direction as hair growth, or if the hair is too short this will cause the hair to break instead of being removed from the root. This can turn into an ingrown hair. To minimise the risk of ingrown hairs always ensure you remove wax in the same direction as hair growth; good lighting is vital so you can determine which way the hair is growing. Also advise clients not to shave hair in between appointments as this makes the hair coarser. Unfortunately, some clients are simply prone to ingrown hairs. Clients should exfoliate skin daily in the shower with an exfoliating scrub or mitt.

Ingrown hairs are formed from either incorrect removal of hair or the hair not being able to grow through the opening of the hair follicle. Symptoms to look for are a slight rash and infected pimples or pustules on the area that was waxed. Ingrown hairs are usually caused when dead skin cells cover the opening of the hair follicle and the new hair becomes trapped under the skin surface. These trapped hairs begin growing inwards and remain under the skin, this causes an infection and pustules may occur. Correct application and removal of the hair will assist in limiting or preventing ingrown hairs. After care advice for the clients would be to exfoliate every second or third day and to apply a little moisturiser to the waxed area. It is recommended that clients exfoliate, as incorrect removal can cause scarring and discomfort. If your client is a sufferer of ingrown hairs, find a product that will assist in preventing ingrown hairs. I like Depilève 'Folisan' which contains salicylic acid to increase exfoliation and antibacterial properties to prevent follicles from elogging up and trapping

the growing hair.

Ingrown hairs begin when dead skin cells accumulate where hair removal has occurred and form a papule while the skin heals. Hair growing in the area then gets trapped under the papule and is prevented from exiting the skin properly, creating an ingrown hair. Many clients experience ingrown hairs through lack of exfoliation, dry skin, tight clothing and sun exposure. If left untreated, ingrown hairs can result in pain, itching, tenderness and in some cases, infection and permanent scarring. To reduce the risk of ingrown hairs, it is recommended the therapist apply a pre-wax cleanser to the area to be waxed and during the treatment they should ensure the entire hair has been removed. An after care lotion should then be applied. A good after eare lotion will remove any wax residue, calm and condition the skin and prevent the formation of ingrown hairs and pustules. It is highly recommended the client exfoliate and moisturise regularly and use an ingrown hair treatment such as Caron's Bump eRaiser, which is designed to prevent and treat ingrown hairs following hair removal.

How do you address post-waxing redness and sensitivity?

Therapists should apply a cream or lotion containing antibacterial and calming properties - tea tree or lavender-based products work well. A cool compress may also be used for those extra sensitive clients. Clients should regularly apply moisturiser containing tea tree, lavender or witch hazel. Aloe vera gel is another great product to counter redness and sensitivity.

The most important thing is to use the right products for your waxing treatments in order to minimise redness and irritation. If redness occurs and if a client is susceptible to ingrown hairs, a cold compress when waxing is completed will cool the skin and reduce excess blood circulation to the freshly waxed area. For example, some clients experience small pustules after lip waxing, as the base of the hair follicle is actually injured during waxing. In some instances, there are even some bleeding follicles as soon as hairs have been removed. Like with any injury, blood rushes to the area to heal and protect, which is exactly what happens with waxing, even if there is no visible bleeding. Once the blood supply becomes active, so do the sebaceous glands. Hours later, dead cells grow over the empty follicles and with the additional oil flow, the oil gets trapped within the follicle and thus some clients end up with pustules. The best way to combat this is to apply a cold compress, which immediately reduces the blood circulation and as soon as this happens, the oil glands will slow down oil production. If the skin is red and sensitive after face waxing, we advise that therapists apply a cold compress on the sensitive area for a minute or two, in order to reduce the overactive blood flow and calm the skin. If client's are particularly sensitive, advise them not to exfoliating for at least one week after waxing and to use a good quality soothing product to help reduce the build up of dry skin.

Clients should ensure they adhere to the aftercare advice given to them by their waxer and they must also use after wax care products correctly, as advised.

An ice pack will reduce redness and ealm the skin, and aloe vera-based products will soothe skin. Clients must be eareful not to expose the skin to the sun or excessive heat and be sure to exfoliate.

Customise each waxing service to suit your client's specific skin and hair type. One wax does not suit every client. Ensure the wax is set at the right temperature and use a soothing product after waxing. Clients should avoid hot showers; keep the water cool. Also make sure clothing isn't too tight; tight jeans after a leg wax is a no-go! Do not use any perfumed shower gels or products on the skin for at least 12 hours. This includes deodorant, because the pores are open and it will sting the area.


Post-waxing redness and sensitivity can be avoided when correct wax for the skin and hair type has been used. Use a cosmetic grade quality, post epilation product that contains an anti inflammatory to calm skin. It's best for elients to avoid activities that might irritate skin, such as going to the beach and laying in the sun. Let the hair follieles settle down. After every shower, condition the skin with a body moisturiser and give yourself a light exfoliation every second or third day.

Apply a cold compress to reduce any inflammation that may occur and apply an after care lotion containing either tea tree or witch hazel to soothe and alleviate bumps and irritation. The client should avoid sun exposure immediately after waxing and be sure to exfoliate and moisturise their skin in between appointments. If the customer suffers from ingrown hairs or has coarse hair a suitable product from the Bump eRaiser range should be used.

"There is a reason why it is called a beauty 'regimen' – regularity is the key! In no area is this more important than in waxing, which is why regular appointments are highly recommended."

Strip waxes should always be applied with the direction of the hair growth and removed in the opposite direction, while hot wax should be applied against the direction of hair growth and removed against. It's vital to always check the temperature of the wax before applying it to the skin to avoid burning. Applying a cold compress or piece of ice on facial waxing can stop white pustules from forming. After any type of waxing it is best to avoid exposure to sun, swimming and strenuous exercise; as the hair follicle is still open, exposure to these can sometime cause infection.

To effectively remove short, stubborn hair, apply hot wax in the opposite direction of the hair growth, firmly scraping the hairs up into the wax with the edge of a waxing spatula. It is like scrapping hard butter on toast. It does not hurt, as the wax acts as a lubricant over the skin as you scrape, so it feels comfortable but is supper effective in removing short, stubborn hairs.

Also ensure you don't let the wax set too long before removing the hair. When performing a Brazilian hot wax, it isn't always possible to remove a wax patch against the hair growth, depending on the body contours of the client. As such it is advisable to have a lifting wax edge on hairless skin at the bottom, as well as at the top of the wax patch, because you may need to remove the wax in the direction of the hair growth, particularly when there are strong; dense hairs on loose skin.
