HAIR: Perfectly **straight** has never been easier with these smoothing sprays and stylers.

Avon Advance Techniques Frizz Control Lotus Shield, \$16.99, 1800 646 000. Almost serum-like, it completely repels water so your hair won't fluff up – no matter how humid it is. (1)

Fudge Urban Straight Hair Stuff, \$10.99, 1300 764 437. Straightens out kinks and protects your locks against heated styling tools up to 230°C. (2)

Garnier Fructis Sleek & Shine Fortifying Shampoo, \$5.95, 1300 659 259. Lots of natural oils for conditioning, but somehow it doesn't weigh hair down. And the fruity smell is always a bonus. (3)

Ghd Reflection Spray, \$35, 1300 880 209, ghd.com/au. On wet hair it works as a detangler, and on dry hair it gives crazy shine. Use pre-straightening. (4)

Goldwell StyleSign Straight Flat Marvel, \$22.95, 1800 506 060. Like an umbrella for your hair, this lets you create relaxed waves and contains ingredients to shield against blowdry-killing humidity. (5)

Herbal Essences Dangerously Straight Leave In Cream, \$5.99, 1800 028 280. For hair slinkier than satin sheets, use this rich treatment on wet or dry hair. (6)

John Frieda Collection Original Formula Frizz-Ease Hair Serum, \$23.99, 1800 468 318. This cult-classic serum polishes up frizz and banishes flyaways for mirror-like shine. (7)

L'Oréal Paris Elvive Nutri-Gloss Illuminating Shampoo, \$6.95, 1300 659 259. This nourishing cleanser is rich and creamy, so sets you up for a frizz-free day. (8)

L'Oréal Professionnel Infinium Lumière Hair Spray, \$14.95, 1300 651 141. Flexible enough to be brushed out and reworked, and the mother-of-pearl extract adds expensive-looking shine. (9)

Matrix Sleek.Look Shampoo, \$24.85, 1300 656 247. Deliciously rich, this first step has ceramides, apricot oil and shea butter, which help seal split ends and flatten frizz. (10)

Macadamia Natural Oil Spray, \$39.95, 1800 251 215. Argan and macadamia oils hydrate faster than a Powerade. And the light misting formula means no grease. (11)

Schwarzkopf Professional Osis+ Softn' Straight, \$28.95, 1800 251 887. Super-creamy, it makes blow-drying a breeze and seals rough cuticles. (12)

Tresemme Thermal Creations Straightening Balm, \$9.95, (02) 8264 5400. Frizz-reducing silicones halve the time it takes to blow-dry – and leave hair with a sleek and shiny finish. (13)

Trilogy Smooth Shine Conditioner, \$20, (03) 9533 1336. Organic rosehip oil hydrates your scalp as well as hair. (14)

Bumble and Bumble Big Shine spray, \$72 from Mecca Cosmetics, 1800 007 844, meccacosmetics.com.au. For ladies-who-lunch polish, lightly spray into dry hair – a little of this high-shine enhancer goes a long way. (15)



HAIR: Go from curly one day to straight the next with the ultimate in hair tools.

BabylissPro Ceramic 19mm Curling Iron, \$77.95, 1800 251 215. Transforms any hair type into big, bouncy, red-carpet curls – no hairstylist required. (1)

BabylissPro Large Ceramic Conical Curling Iron, \$94.95, 1800 251 215. Creates water waves or ringlets with ease. Wind pieces (how tightly you wrap dictates the style) around the cone-shaped wand and release. (2)

Brushworx Keratin 230 Large Curved Vent Brush, \$11.95, 1800 251 215. Good for all hair types, this huge brush has massive vents to add volume as you blow-dry. (3)

Ghd IV Styler, \$239, 1300 880 209, ghddhair.com/au. A cult classic for a reason, this smooth-plated styling essential curls as well as straightens. (4)

Hair Bungee, \$5.30 for set of 4, 1300 181 441. Designed to use as tight or loose as you need, with no snagging. Hook one end into hair, wrap around the pony and fasten with the other hook. (5)

Kevin.Murphy Hair.Curlers, \$30 for 10, 1800 104 204. So simple to use, these leave hands free to finish your make-up prep. (6)

Label.m Mini Texture Straightener, \$98, (02) 9380 2059. Proof that good things come in small packages. Perfect for short styles or touch-ups. (7)

Parlux 3800 Eco Friendly Ionic & Ceramic Dryer, \$189.95, 1800 251 215. Made of recyclable materials, the silencer nixes noise and a super-fast motor means you'll spend less time and energy styling. (8)

Remington Crimptini, \$22.95, 1800 623 118. Use at the roots under your style for massive volume, or all over your head for wild waves. (9)

Remington Curls Curls Curls, \$43.95, 1800 623 118. Get more bang for your buck with this tong. Four separate attachments mean you can create volume, waves or curls – all with a quick switch of the curling head. (10)

Silver Bullet Obsession 3700 Dryer, \$129.95, 1800 251 215. Negative ions lock in moisture while you dry your hair, so you get a frizz-free 'do every time. (11)

Taylor Madison by Brushworx Anti-Static Styling Brush, \$16.95, 1800 251 215. Prevent annoying flyaways from static electricity with this rubber-based brush. (12)

Tangle Teezer, \$29.50, (02) 9487 8011. This clever comb is designed to work conditioner through your hair in the shower – so you don't snap wet strands post-shampoo. (13)

Cloud Nine TheO, \$299 and rollers, \$29 for pack of 4, 1300 294 247. Heats curlers in just seconds to give you bouncy, sleek hair in minutes. (14)

VS Sassoon Big Styler, \$99.95, 1800 650 263. It's a motorised brush that dries and styles hair in a jiffy, creating major volume with barely any effort. Great for the time-poor. (15)
