WHERE TO WEAR: A garden party.
HOW TO GET IT: Eugene Souleiman,
global creative director at Wella
Professionals, suggests applying a sea
salt spray to damp lengths before blasting them dry. Using a tail comb, create a
centre part. Then, separate a small section of hair from behind your ear and
plait it. "Don't worry about perfection,"
offers Souleiman. A few stray strands
around the face only enhance this style.
Secure the end of your braid with a small
rubber elastic and then wrap it around
the top of your head (where you would
place a headband), stopping above your

ear on the other side. Then tuck the end of the elastic back up underneath the braid to disguise the join.

PRO TIP: To get a relaxed texture, "rather than flipping your head upside down to dry your hair, direct the nozzle of your hairdryer upwards at your cuticle to create more texture", says Cain.

TOP PICKS: Blast dry using the Parlux 3800 Eco Friendly Ionic & Ceramic Hairdryer, \$189.95. Then, add movement with Toni & Guy Casual Sea Salt Texturising Spray, \$15.99, and secure using Smoothies Snag-Free Ponytail Holders, from \$6.50 for a pack of 24. ▶
