NEW DIRECTION: "A good fringe never goes out of fashion," points out Thompson, and this season there are plenty of looks to choose from. From full and lash-grazing at Emilio Pucci to short and choppy at Louis Vuitton, there's a look for everyone. WHO IT SUITS: "Fringes complement strong facial features," comments Thompson. He adds that side-swept fringes are perfect for square and angular face shapes, while arched options can help to balance long faces. If you're not sure which length will work for you, ask your stylist to trim lengths gradually - longer at first, taking them up in increments until you reach the perfect length.
