PARTING WAYS

It's one of the easiest ways to update your look: this season, top hairstylists switched from classic centre parts to the more defined, side-swept styles seen at Balmain and Michael Kors. Perfect for ponytails, up-dos and poker-straight strands, the trend was definitely off centre.

top tip:

For a sleek, shiny style, place the tip of a tail comb where you want your part line to start and pull it backwards. Follow it with your index finger to the point you want it to end – leaving your remaining lengths to flow free. To finish, rub a small amount of serum between your palms and smooth either side of your part line.

SHOW OF HANDS
