
NEW DETAILS EMERGE ON

Footage has emerged of pop legend Prince entering his doctor's office to collect pills just 24 hours before the singer's death due to a fatal drug overdose. The 57-year-old musician looked pale and withdrawn as he entered the clinic.

The clip was released last week during the investigation, where the County Attorney Mark Metz confirmed Prince had died of a Fentanyl overdose - a synthetic opioid - which can be lethal in high doses and is 50 times more powerful than heroin.

During his visit to Dr Schulenberg, Prince complained of feeling antsy, and during the examination Prince had a urine test that showed he had three opiates in his system already which led the doctor to suggest the Purple Rain hitmaker was suffering from opiate withdrawal.

Despite the doctor being fined \$30,000 for supplying oxycodone to Prince's bodyguard - with the intent it would go to Prince - Dr Schulenberg is not being investigated for supplying the star with Fentanyl.



ABBY LEE MILLER SHARES SHOCKING SELFIE AFTER CANCER DIAGNOSIS



The Dance Moms star has shared her first selfie since being diagnosed with Burkitt lymphoma.

The 51-year-old was hospitalised two weeks ago and underwent emergency surgery to save her life. It was initially believed she had an infection in her spine, but it was later discovered it was cancer that

was causing her excruciating pain.

Burkitt lymphoma is a cancer that grows in the immune cells, and if not treated, can quickly become fatal.

Along with the selfie from her hospital bed, Abby wrote: 'So much gratitude and love for those who listened, those who looked deeper and those who leapt into action."
