From dark to white-blonde, we have seen many lightened locks hitting the red carpet recently, and from Lady Gaga's award season to Hilary Duff's post-baby makeover, we are loving these daring 1990's shades.

GET THE LOOK: "There are so many shades of blonde! Doing your research and bringing in reference pics will help your colourist understand whether you're wanting a cool blonde, like Gaga's, or a nude blonde with a Scandinavian hairline," says McMahon. PRO TIP: When lightening up, the main focus is all about hair health and your personal skin and eye tones. "You need to have great condition to sign up to wear these looks. You will also need to treat this hair religiously! It can be achieved from either a full bleaching service or can also be achieved through freehand colour over time," says Clements. Be aware that regrowth will be prominent, depending on how light or dark you are naturally, requiring a root touch-up and toning session every four to five weeks, says Clements, adding, "Toning to achieve this type of blonde is a mix of a sand and ice toning. I recommend to all of my bleach clients that they treat the hair twice a week and always use heat protection when styling."

DLOUR POP!

Are you game enough to brave candy shades and metallic hues? "Metallic tones have been in for a few years now and I love them! From silver and slate grey to icy steel blues and greens, there is much to choose from," says Clements.

GET THE LOOK: Clements advises lightening up first. "This colour is toned after having a full-scalp lightener. Maintenance is every four to five weeks."

PRETTY IN PINK: Shades of pink can be soft and flirty, especially on long locks like Julia Roberts'. "I can't deny a love for creative colours that have a low commitment and give the hair an extra shine," says McMahon.

PRO TIP: "Maintaining the hair health is a high priority, we use Christophe Robin's lavender oil before colour, followed by Olaplex after rinsing out the bleach, and then a super-nourishing cleansing mask with lemon to finish. If you are a scalp-bleach girl or have lots of foils, this should replace your shampoo!" says McMahon.
